

Benefits:

- No entrance exam: students whose average of the last 4 (four) years completed at the secondary level is equal to or greater than 8 (eight) will be exempt from the UTDT entrance exam.
- Scholarships:
- All those students whose average between 2nd and 5th year is greater than or equal to 8 (eight) may apply to obtain up to a 20% scholarship.
- Students who, having obtained one of the 3 highest averages from 2nd to 5th year and recommended by Colegio Bilingüe Neuquén, may apply to obtain up to a 50% scholarship.
- All CBN students who live more than 100 km from Buenos Aires and whose average between 2nd and 5th year is greater than or equal to 7 (seven) may apply to obtain up to a 50% scholarship.

Requirements:

- Photocopy of your analytical certificate or the bulletins of the last 4 completed years.
- Certificate of regular student

Observations:

- Scholarships will be awarded in accordance with the provisions of the specific regulations for granting scholarships of the UTDT.
- The CBN graduates included in this agreement must satisfy all the administrative registration requirements and the University obligations established for all applicants to enter the UTDT.
